Dear Attorney General Bondi and Director Patel,

I am writing in regard to the recent wave of organized attacks targeting Elon Musk and Tesla car dealerships, charging stations, and vehicles across the country. These attacks, which seem to involve coordinated acts of vandalism, arson, and other acts of violence, seriously threaten public safety. Reports suggest that groups like Antifa, known for their history of domestic terrorism, including throughout the summer of 2020 following the death of George Floyd, may be involved in the recent Tesla attacks. I urge the Department of Justice and the Federal Bureau of Investigation to prioritize a thorough investigation into these matters.

There have been several attacks of this kind in recent days, with reports, including from Elon Musk himself, linking various Democrat-affiliated non-governmental organizations (NGOs) to them, specifically, Troublemakers, Disruption Project, Rise & Resist, Indivisible Project, and the Democratic Socialists of America (DSA). These groups receive a significant amount of funding from ActBlue, a Democrat superPAC.

There are many examples of this extremism. On March 3, seven Tesla charging stations at a mall outside of Boston were set on fire in the middle of the night. On March 6, police in Portland responded to gunshots fired at a Tesla dealership in the middle of the night. A woman from Colorado is facing a federal charge of malicious destruction of property for vandalizing a Tesla dealership. She spray-painted words like "Nazi" on cars and the building and threw Molotov cocktails. And on March 9, several Tesla Cybertrucks were set on fire and burned through the night at a lot in Seattle.

These attacks prompt many questions regarding their nature and background. Specifically:

- 1. Who is organizing and carrying out these attacks? Identifying the individuals and groups responsible is essential to preventing further violence and ensuring those responsible are held accountable.
- 2. Is there a link between NGOs and the organizers of these attacks? If such connections exist, they must be fully investigated to determine the extent of their involvement and influence, and to identify the individuals directly responsible.

3. If NGOs are linked to these attacks, has federal funding been provided to any of them? The American public deserves transparency and assurance that their tax dollars are not being used to fund domestic political terrorism.

Thank you for your attention to this matter and for your steadfast commitment to justice and public safety.
